WHAT? The workshop is participation based, providing athletes and their mentors the tools and skills to speak on behalf of Special Olympics Wyoming. Participants will be introduced to the Athlete Leadership Programs (ALP's), become familiar with presentation materials, learn appropriate dress and behavior and demonstrate an understanding of the mission of Special Olympics.

Each athlete (Global Messenger) must commit to schedule and make two presentations in their own community during the year following the training. In addition, athletes may be asked to represent Special Olympics Wyoming at statewide events and activities.
